### 1.1 Dépendances

Pour installer les dépendances, taper :

```
sudo apt-get install python-lxml python-mako python-egenix-mxdatetime python-dateutil  
python-psycopg2 python-pychart python-pydot python-tz python-reportlab python-yaml  
python-vobject
```

### 1.2 Télécharger OpenERP Server

Télécharger OpenERP Server sur <http://www.openerp.com/downloads><sup>2</sup>

### 1.3 Démarrer OpenERP Server

Taper :

```
tar -xzf openerp-server-6.0.0.tar.gz  
cd openerp-server-6.0.0/bin  
python openerp-server.py
```
