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1.0 Introduction

This program directory is intended for the system programmer responsible for program installation and maintenance. It contains information concerning the material and procedures associated with the installation of IBM SEARCH2000 for AS/400. Please read the content of this program directory before installing the SEARCH2000 program and then keep this document for future reference.

The program directory contains the following sections:

- 2.0, "Program Materials" on page 2 identifies the basic and optional program materials and documentation for SEARCH2000.
- 3.0, "Program Support" on page 5 describes the IBM support available for SEARCH2000.
- 4.0, "Program and Service Level Information" on page 6 lists the APARs (program level) and PTFs (service level) incorporated into SEARCH2000.
- 5.0, "Installation Requirements and Considerations" on page 7 identifies the resources and considerations for installing and using SEARCH2000.
- 6.0, "Before You Start" on page 9 provides instructions on how to acquire a software key.
- 7.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 11 provides detailed installation instructions for SEARCH2000.

Before installing SEARCH2000, read 3.1, "Preventive Service Planning" on page 5. This section tells you how to find any updates to the information and procedures in this program directory.

2.0 Program Materials

An IBM program is identified by a program number and a feature code. The program number for SEARCH2000 is 5697-C72.

The program announcement material describes the features supported by SEARCH2000. Ask your IBM marketing representative for this information if you have not already received a copy.

2.1 Basic Machine-Readable Material

The distribution medium for this program is 9-track magnetic tape (written at either 1600 or 6250 BPI), 3480 cartridge, 1/4-inch tape cartridge, or CD-ROM. The tape or cartridge or CD-ROM contains all the programs and data needed for installation. SEARCH2000 is installed using RSTLICPGM. See 7.0, "Installation Instructions" on page 11 for more information on how to install the program. Figure 1 describes the tape, cartridge, and CD-ROM. Figure 2 on page 3 describes the file content of the program medium.

5.0 Installation Requirements and Considerations

The following sections identify the system requirements for installing SEARCH2000.

5.1 Target System Requirements

This section describes the environment of the target system required to install and use SEARCH2000.

5.1.1 Operating System Requirements

SEARCH2000 operates with the following IBM Application System/400 operating systems

CISC version of the OS/400* - V3R1, V3R2 RISC version of the OS/400* - V3R6 or higher

5.1.2 Machine Requirements

There are no special machine requirements for the target system.

5.1.3 Programming Requirements

See 5.2, "Program Considerations" for additional software requirements.

5.1.4 DASD Storage Requirements

The program requires 10 MB of auxiliary storage.

5.1.5 Processor Storage Requirements

There are no special allocation requirements.

5.2 Program Considerations

The following sections list the programming considerations for installing SEARCH2000 and activating its functions.

5.2.1 Operating System Requirements

The OS/400 operating system is used to install SEARCH2000.

5.2.2 Machine Requirements

There are no special machine requirements for the target system.

5.2.3 Programming Considerations

When installing SEARCH2000 on a system with the primary language other than English, users must check the system CCSID value and apply this value to all the physical source files in the QTK2000 library. This step should be performed immediately after SEARCH2000 is installed.

- 1. Use command DSPSYSVAL QCCSID to display the current system CCSID parameter. Take note of this parameter value.
- 2. Use command CHGSRCPF to change all the PF source files in the QTK2000 library with the correct CCSID value (recorded from the previous step).

5.2.4 System Considerations

In order to gain access to all functions of SEARCH2000, the product must first be activated with a software key. Users should acquire the software key for the target system prior to installation. (Refer to 6.0, "Before You Start" on page 9)

It is strongly recommended to have the latest PTF CUM tape installed on your operating system (especially for COBOL runtime, SQL runtime and Query/400 runtime).

5.2.5 Special Considerations

If a previous version of the SEARCH2000 product exists on the system, it is advisable to first remove the product with DLTLICPGM before installing SEARCH2000 V3R1M1.

6.0 Before You Start

Before installing SEARCH2000 you must first acquire a software key for the product. This key is supplied by HAL** S.p.A., Italy, and is unique to each system. To obtain a valid software key, you must send the serial number of the target AS/400 to HAL by fax or e-mail. In return, HAL will assign a software key and send it back to you. The normal turn around time is one full business day.

If you already have a software key for the previous release of IBM SEARCH2000 for AS/400, you can apply the same key for this version of the product.

7.0 Installation Instructions

This chapter describes the installation method and the step-by-step procedures to install and to activate the functions of SEARCH2000.

7.1 Installing SEARCH2000

7.1.1 Overview

SEARCH2000 is a Licensed Program Offering. It is distributed on its own program medium. Instead of using the GO LICPGM command to install, the entire product is installable with the RSTLICPGM command. Your user ID must be at *SECOFR authority level to install the product.

7.1.2 Installation Procedure

7.1.2.1 First Time Installations

1. If a previous version of the IBM SEARCH2000 for AS/400 product exists on the system, remove it by entering the following command on the command line:

```
DLTLICPGM LICPGM(5697C72)
```

This will delete the product library QSR2000 from the system.

- 2. Load program tape/cartridge/CD-ROM into your system loading device.
- 3. At the command line, enter:

```
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5697C72)

DEV(yyyyy) - where yyyyy is the loading device of your system
```

- 4. The library QTK2000 will be restored on your system.
- 5. (Non-English machines only, refer to Programming Consideration in Chapter 5 to check CCSID value.)
- 6. Enter ADDLIBLE QTK2000 and press the Enter key.
- 7. Activate SEARCH2000 (refer to 7.2 Activating SEARCH2000 section).
- 8. Invoke SEARCH2000 with the command SR2000.

7.1.2.2 Installing SEARCH2000 using secondary language option

- 1. Load program tape/cartridge/CD-ROM into your system loading device.
- 2. Use the RSTLICPGM command to install SEARCH2000. Specify the following option:

```
RSTLICPGM LICPGM(5697C72)

DEV(yyyyy) - where yyyyy is the loading device of your system RSTOBJ(*LNG)

LNG(29xx) - where xx identifies the language code
```

Enter - CHKPRDOPT PRDID(5697C72) to ensure message - 'No errors detected by CHKPRDOPT' is displayed.

- 4. Enter CHGSYSLIBL LIB(QSYS29xx), where xx is the identified language code, to position QSYS29xx on top of your library list (if your environment is not already setup as such).
- 5. Enter ADDLIBLE QTK2000 and press the Enter key.
- 6. Follow the steps in Section 7.2 to activate SEARCH2000.

Note: The installation process creates a new library named QTK2000 on your system and copies the SEARCH2000 language objects to QSYS29xx library.

7.1.2.3 Re-Installing SEARCH2000

- 1. Remove the SEARCH2000 product before re-installing. (Refer to Deleting SEARCH2000 in this chapter.)
- 2. Follow the steps documented in the First Time Installations section.
- 3. You must re-apply the software key after re-installation. Follow the steps in Section 7.2 to activate SEARCH2000.

7.2 Activating SEARCH2000

SEARCH2000 is normally invoked by the command - SR2000. However, after the installation or reload of SEARCH2000, you must first apply the SEARCH2000 software key, before all functions are accessible.

- 1. Add QTK2000 into your library list with the command ADDLIBLE QTK2000.
- 2. At the command line, enter SR2000KEY and press the Enter key.
- 3. The "Apply SEARCH2000 Software Key" screen will appear.
- 4. Enter the software key information (provided by HAL S.p.A).
- 5. After completion, you will return to the previous menu without a message.

7.3 Deleting SEARCH2000

To remove SEARCH2000 from your AS/400, do the following:

- 1. At the command line, enter DLTLICPGM LICPGM(5697C72) and press the Enter key.
- 2. This will delete the entire QTK2000 library.
