- All future enhancements and requirements will ONLY be made to and address WDI 3.2+ DT Mapper



Number 8

- WDI Client supports Multiple Runtime environments
 - ▶ Setup, view and export to different systems
 - Development, Test, Production

Number 7

- Common Database for Server and Client
 - ▶ Eliminates Conversion between Host and Client
 - ▶ Allows for additional standards capability
 - Standards purpose, notes, etc.
 - Allows for Data Format re-use



Number 6

- Extensive Online Help
 - Reduces dependency on manuals
 - Now in Mapping Command Window

- Easy End User Customization of Client
 - Windows
 - Queries
 - Colors
 - Columns



Number 4

- Better Integration with other WebSphere Products
 - ▶ **WebSphere MQ Series**
 - RFH2 Header
 - Message type and routing information
 - WDI Adaptors for MQ
 - Supports single or multiple concurrent processes
 - ▶ **WebSphere Business Integration Connect**
 - Via WMQ
 - ▶ **WebSphere BI Message Broker**
 - MCD – Message Content Descriptor
 - Describes message content and format type

Number 3

- Validation Mapping
 - Based on years of requirements
 - Allows further validation of data without modifying standards



Number 2

- Enhanced XML Support
 - ▶ DTD and Schema
 - Single pass transformation
 - XML Split Capability (CSD 14)
