The US Federal Department of Education has released the guidelines for \$4 billion in grants available under the "Race to the Top" program. Designed to spur innovation in how schools drive the highest possible levels of student achievements – to raise academic standards, improve teacher quality, and expand the reach of charter schools -- this represents the largest grant ever managed by a US Secretary of Education. But schools, school districts and state Departments of Education must demonstrate measurable success and comply with strict reporting requirements.
