  - **The cycle of System Management (Scheduling and load)**



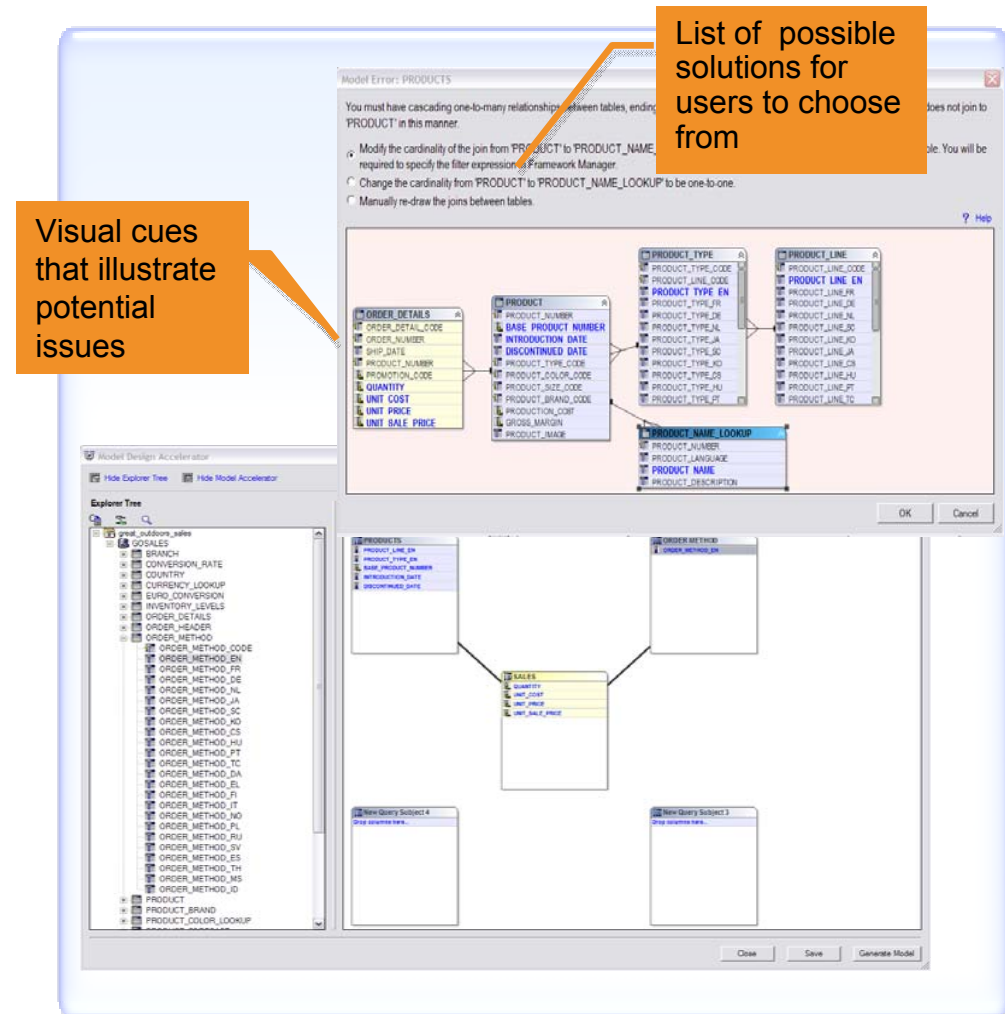

  - Guidance from best practices to ensure on-going evaluation to optimize model design

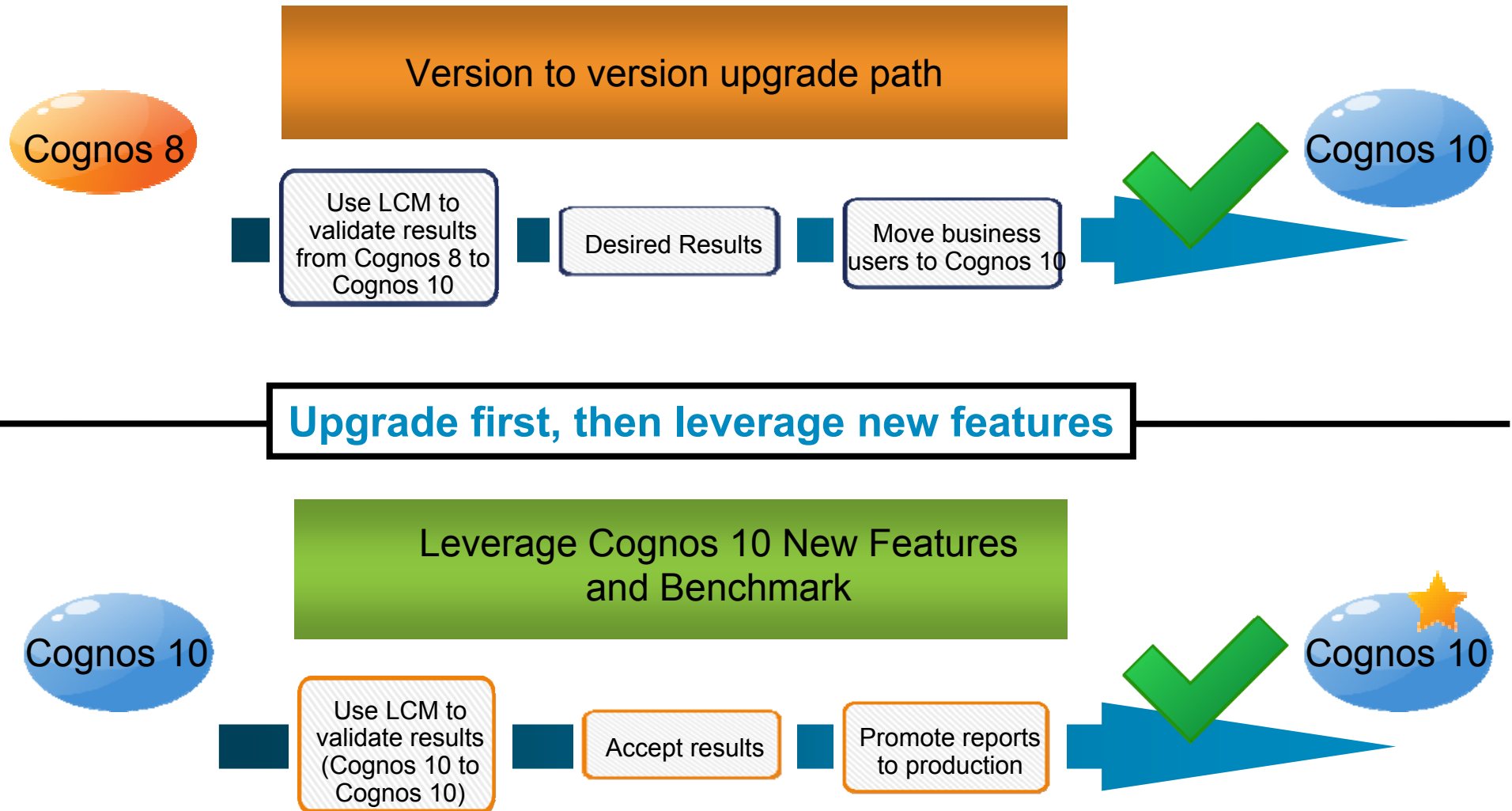

# Upgrading Reports to Cognos 10

## New Capabilities in Cognos 10

### Lifecycle manager

- Validates report content by comparing outputs from reports across multiple output formats to improve the upgrade process.
- Validate reports from Dev/Test to Production or different environments and as a light-weight benchmark to identify how changes may impact performance

### Benefits

- Streamline and speed up testing process
- Test and benchmark changes within solution environments
- Validate a higher number of reports

### Multi-version coexistence

- Enables clients to run multiple versions of the product through a single Cognos 10 portal. 2 content stores being accessed through a single instance of Cognos Connection

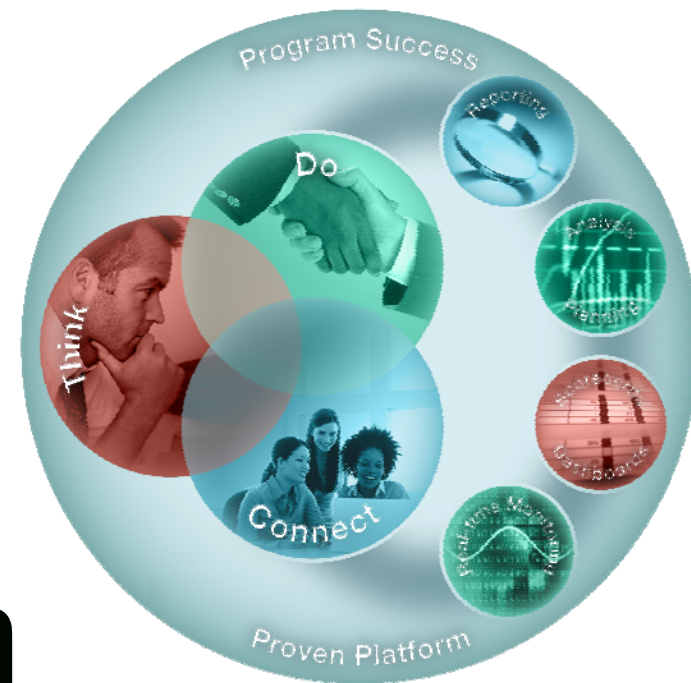
### Benefits

- Stage the upgrade process
- Align with IT capacity and still address business demands for new capabilities
- Provide the business with a more seamless experience through the upgrade process

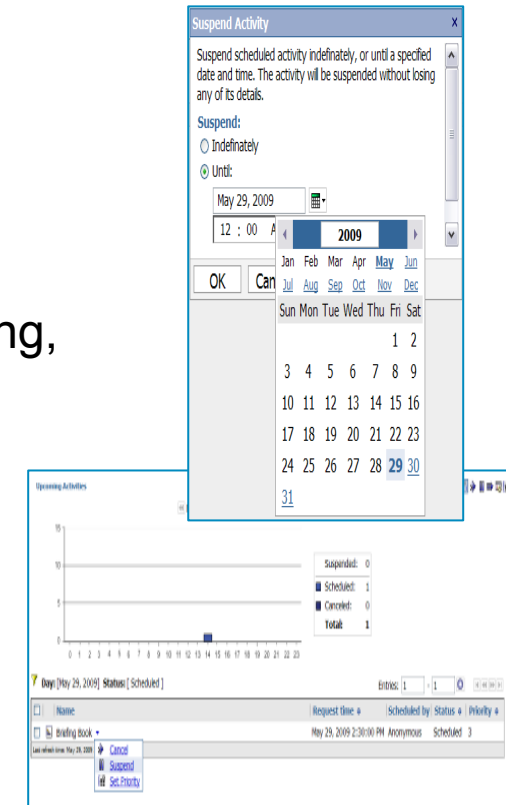
# Enhanced System Management

## Key Capabilities

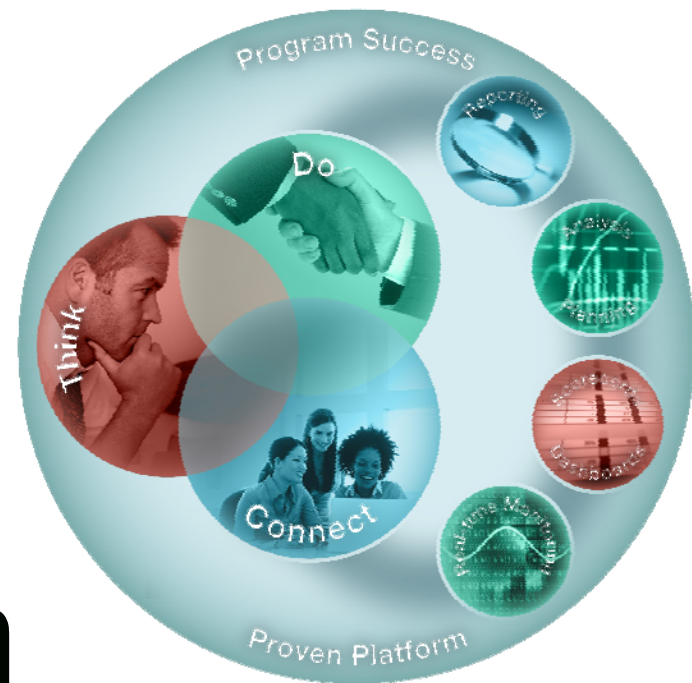
- Scheduling – Improved options for user-based scheduling, credential renewals, and schedule management options
- Automatic credential and sign-on renewals
- System Monitoring – Improved capability to monitor upcoming, suspended, cancelled and advanced upcoming activities
- Audit improvements – Improved flexibility for user specific tracing

## Benefits

- Better control on scheduling to better manage system load and resources
- Greater report execution history to better plan and control system load
- Decrease the number of failed jobs/reports improves system user adoption
- Enhanced security monitoring makes it easier to apply security governance
