- "I understand that I must migrate to IBM Cognos 8 now because Series 7 is being discontinued"
- "If I'm using PowerPlay today, I should migrate to Analysis Studio"
- "Migration Tools are all I need to get to IBM Cognos 8"
- "I can only have dual support licenses for Series 7 and IBM Cognos 8 for 12 months"

### Common Issues Organizations Face

- Cost of Ownership
  - Complex administration of many products unnecessary high costs
  - Need to administer BI on too many Windows desktops across your company
  - Products that require too much different training
- Globalization
  - Lots of data in lots of languages in your global organization
  - Lots of people wanting BI capabilities with user interfaces in their own languages
- Agility
  - Rapidly changing demands for new capabilities
  - Need better integration with your infrastructure
  - Need to be able to dynamically balance loads





## The Power of IBM Cognos 8 BI: One Product, One Architecture

- Lower Cost of Ownership
  - All BI capabilities in one product
  - Zero-footprint, web-based user interface plus flexible access modes
- Global
  - Unicode\*
  - Built for a global audience
- Highly Agile
  - Openness leverage existing security, portal, app servers; access to relational or OLAP data from any capability
  - Web services-based Services Oriented Architecture (SOA) that fits into complex environments


# Evaluate your Existing Applications and Determine Migration Approach

- You have
  - Many applications with many data sources
  - Used in many sites / locations
  - Serving multiple communities of users, with different needs
- One size does not fit all
  - Just as all customers and their applications are different, each migration plan is similar but unique
  - Successful migration require the right approaches for your needs





#### **Understanding Your Options**



- Option 1: Wait
  - Stay with Series 7 for the near future
- Option 2: Migrate applications to IBM Cognos 8
  - All At Once
- Option 3: "Best of Both Worlds"
  - Planned, staged migration, possibly with interoperability

One, two or all options may be applicable to you depending on your applications


#### **Choice influenced by many factors**

- Desire for IBM Cognos 8 benefits and how soon you want them
- Application Portfolio Type, Age, Size, Number of Applications
- User Communities, Their Current and Future Needs
- Budget and other External Factors



## **Option 1: Wait**

- You don't have to migrate right now
- Benefits
  - Continuity for your business users
  - Less disruption
- Risks
  - Missing opportunities available with IBM Cognos 8
    - TCO, globalization, and agility
- Do what's right for your business when you need to







#### The Future of Series 7

- Series 7 will continue to be developed and maintained as long as customers demand it and it makes business sense
  - There is no End-of-Support date
  - http://support.cognos.com/supported/en/support/w hatscoming/series7 commitment.html
- New Series 7 Releases:
  - Series 7 Version 4 Summer 2006: Continued product enhancements
  - Series 7 Version 4 Maintenance Releases 2007, 2008, 2009...
  - Series 7 Version 5 in planning



## Option 2: Migrate all applications to IBM Cognos 8

- Fastest route to IBM Cognos 8
- Benefits
  - Get to IBM Cognos 8 benefits faster
    - TCO, globalization, and agility



- Conceptually simple but can be high risk
  - Application portfolio will determine ease of migration
  - Differences exist between Series 7 and IBM Cognos 8
- May not realize opportunities to fully benefit from IBM Cognos 8
  - Need experience with IBM Cognos 8
- Mistakes can be expensive
- Can be disruptive to business users must absorb change quickly (training needed)







## Option 3: Best of Both Worlds – Recommended

- Safest route to IBM Cognos 8 for most customers
  - 1. Build new applications with IBM Cognos 8
  - 2. Migrate most PowerPlay users and applications to PowerPlay 8
  - Maintain other Series 7 applications "as is", set up interoperability between Series 7 and IBM Cognos 8, as necessary
  - 4. Then, with a pragmatic plan, gradually migrate existing applications & users to IBM Cognos 8
- Benefits
  - Gets you to the same place as "All at Once", but lower risk and disruption to end users
  - More predictable results
- Risks
  - Likely takes longer than "All at Once"
  - More overhead costs more to administer (2 infrastructures, 2 sets of hardware, 2 skill sets, etc)





### Technical Migration Approaches

#### **LIFT & SHIFT**

- Replicate reports in new environment "as is"
- Focus on moving batches of BI elements quickly
- Can use offshore approach for additional savings of time and money
- Good candidate: PowerPlay applications

#### **HYBRID**


- Customize a combination of both approaches as makes sense for your business needs
- Leverage efficiency gains (compress & optimize) while quickly moving (lift & shift) essential reports
- Good candidate: PowerPlay applications with drillthrough to IWR

#### **COMPRESS & OPTIMIZE**


- Eliminate redundant or unnecessary reports
- Focus on new features
   & technology of IBM
   Cognos 8 to improve on existing applications
- Identify today (and tomorrow's) business needs & ensure they are met
- Good candidate: IBM Cognos Visualizer applications






