





Main window of SwisTrack.

- General-purpose tracking tool
- Component-based design
- Configuration panes for on-line configuration
- Visualization of intermediate steps
- Simple interface (TCP, NMEA, XML)
- Support for USB, Firewire and GigE cameras; various video formats
- Cross-platform (Windows, Linux)
- Easy-to-use user interface
- Extensive documentation

SwisTrack is Extendable


- Implement your own algorithm as a new component
- Reuse the framework and other components for your task
- Simple, documented interface
- Create configuration panes (XML)
- Visualize intermediate steps of your algorithm
- Optimize your code by measuring execution times
- Document your component, and provide to the community


Application Example 1: Real-time Robot Tracking

Application Example 2: Tracking Animals on Videos


Trajectory analysis of animals
