Wikimedia New Zealand is a *proposed* chapter of the Wikimedia Foundation. The document outlines the proposal for a chapter for Wikimedians living in New Zealand.

The Wikimedia Foundation, Inc. is a nonprofit charitable organization dedicated to encouraging the growth, development and distribution of free, multilingual content, and to providing the full content of these wiki-based projects to the public free of charge. The Wikimedia Foundation operates some of collaboratively largest reference projects in the world, such as Wikipedia, the award-winning multilingual encyclopedia. Other projects include Wikibooks, free, opencontent textbooks; Wikinews, a free source: Wikiquote, news compendium of quotations; Wikisource, a free library; Wikispecies, an open, free di-rectory of species; and Wiktionary, a free multilingual dictionary.

The Wikimedia projects have an international scope, and their outreach has already made a significant impact throughout the world, regularly appearing in the top ten websites around the world. To continue this success on an organisational level, Wikimedia is supporting the independent creation of an international network of associated organisations.

Local chapters, like the proposed Wikimedia New Zealand, are fully independent organisations that share the goals of the Wikimedia Foundation and them within а specified support geographical region. In addition to supporting the Wikimedia Foundation, the Wikimedia community and the Wikimedia projects collecting by donations, organising local events and projects and spreading the word of Wikimedia, they also provide a source of education and support in the participation of developing free and open content and in 'Wiki' culture. They also provide the community and potential partners with a point of contact capable of fulfilling specific local needs and are involved with additional education-related projects and activities.



Roles a New Zealand Food for Though chapter would play

- Promotion of Wikimedia projects and Free content in general.
- Encourage the use of Wikimedia resources in education.
- Provide a first point of contact for media seeking comment from New Zealand contributors to Wikimedia projects.
- Recruit New Zealanders to contribute to WikiMedia Foundation projects.
- Organise conventions, workshops, and attend conferences.

To do List

- Talk to the UK chapter about their experience in setting up a local chapter.
- Talk to the Aussies about how their proposal is going
- Talk to other Kiwi organisations about their experience in incorporating in New Zealand.
- Work on adopting a constitution, and, get the draft one checked by professional advice.
- File to become an Incorporated Society. <-- At least 15 people are required legally.
- Hold the First AGM- Elect first Committee
- Appoint a contact person for purposes such as producing press releases and responding to media.
- Seek professional advice on defamation.
- Consider public liability insurance.
- Start fulfilling our aims as set out in the Constitution

- Why might we want to setup a local chapter?
- If we setup a local chapter, what implications are there?
- How does the chapter serve its members? They are paying for membership after all.
- Is it actually possible for an Incorporated Society in New Zealand to transfer proceeds of donations to a US based organisation?
