SUBJECT: 8 October 2009 Detainee Review Board (DRB) Recommendation Approval/Disapproval

1. I have reviewed the findings and recommendations of the DRB conducted on 8 October 2009 concerning the intermment of Detainee 3154. The DRB made the following findings and recommendations:

a. That ISN 3154 is a person who was part of, or substantially supported, Taliban or al-Qaida forces or associated forces that are engaged in hostilities against the United States or its coalition partners, including any person who has committed a belligerent act, or has directly supported hostilities, in aid of such enemy armed forces.

b. That internment is necessary to mitigate the threat ISN 3154 poses.

c. That ISN 3154 is not an Enduring Security Threat.

2. (approve) Mtdisapprove\_\_\_\_\_ the transfer of ISN 3154 to the Afghan authorities for criminal prosecution.

[Detainee 3154 entered the boardroom and took his seat in front of the board members.]

The detainee was advised by the president of how this board was not a criminal trial and how this board was to determine whether or not he met the criteria for further internment.

The president also notified the detainee that he may be present at all open sessions of the board permitting that he acted appropriately. ISN 3154 was also advised that he could testify under oath or unsworn if he wished to do so, that he had a personal representative which was present at the hearing, that he may present information at the hearing including the testimony of witnesses, and that he can examine documents presented to the board all of which the detainee understood.

Further, ISN 3154 was instructed that, at the conclusion of the board after the legal review, the board would determine whether he met the criteria for further internment at the Bagram Theater Internment Facility. The detainee understood the fact that if he does not meet the criteria, then he would be released as soon as possible. However, if he did meet the criteria, then he would be recommended for further internment, transferred to Afghan authorities, or released without conditions.

### [The unclassified hearing was called to order at 1158, 8 October 2009.]

 $_{(b)(3),\ 10\ USC\ 130b;\ (b)(6)}$  presented the following unclassified information to the board:

ISN 3154 was captured on 6 February 2007 in  $^{(b)(1); (b)(2); (b)(5)}$ . He is assessed to be an insurgent facilitator.

[Per the recorders request, the president granted a classified hearing at the culmination of the unclassified hearing.]

The detainee, ISN 3154, made the following statement to the board:

I have never fought with anyone. I am innocent. It is common for Afghans to make up stories. Nobody found any evidence.

The president allowed the board to ask the following questions of Detainee 3154:

#### QUESTIONING OF ISN 3154

Questions by DAB Recorder 2:

"(b)(6)

" lives near my house nut I do not know him.

Questions by Member 1:

I went to school at the Madrassa when I was 8 years old. I am only a farmer and I do not know anyone with explosives.

Questions by President:

"(b)(6) " is my father. I am a farmer: I grow vegetables on 1 acre of land. "Mohmand" is my name.

The president announced the conclusion of the unclassified hearing.

The president of the board instructed the detainee that he would be notified of the board's decision within a couple of weeks and that he would be released if the decision is made that further internment would not be required. However, if the board decided that further internment is required, he would be retained at the Bagram Theater Internment Facility, released to Afghan authorities for participation in a reconciliation program, or released without conditions. Furthermore, if continued internment was recommended, then an additional Detainee Review Board would be reconvened in 6 months.

[The unclassified hearing adjourned at 1210, 8 October 2009.]

[Detainee 3154 withdrew from the boardroom.]

### [The classified hearing was called to order at 1211, 8 October 2009.]
