Sir,

The prosecution does not oppose the defense's requested continuance in *United States v. Hashim* until the week of 17 November to allow defense counsel to take care of his medical needs. However, we oppose any delay in arraignment beyond the week of 17 November.

Additionally, in the event the Court grants a delay, the prosecution requests that the Court find that the time between 6 November and the date of the arraignment be excluded for speedy trial accountability in accordance with R.M.C. 707(c).
