In my memorandum of March 5, 1970, I informed you that the Canadian Government had delayed for some eight months the (b)(1) agreement, when finally signed on (b)(1)

Diplomatic notes were exchanged on June 30 for the (b)(1) (b)(1) The Canadian Cabinet maintained, however, that since it still had not completed its policy review of North American defense it was (b)(1)

**MEMORANDUM FOR DR. KISSINGER**

**SUBJECT: Agreement with Canada on (b)(1)**

In your memorandum dated April 24, 1969, transmitting the President's approval of recommendations made in my memorandum dated April 19, 1969, concerning the (b)(1) agreement with Canada on (b)(1) (b)(1) you requested to be kept informed of our negotiations with the Canadians.

We failed to move ahead as rapidly as desired in (b)(1) the agreement, not because of any substantive differences, but due to the Canadian Government's review of North American defense and other bureaucratic delays.

(b)(1) The Canadian Government has (b)(1)  
The agreement provides for Canadian Government (b)(1)

No definite number of (b)(1) is prescribed. The (b)(1) will be arranged on a service-to-service basis with operational details to be provided to the Canadian Armed Forces by the (b)(1)
