Cooperation

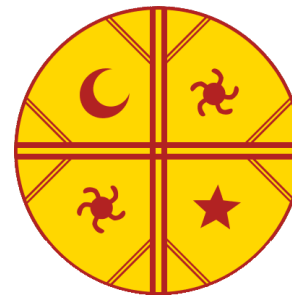
A pillar of our projects should also be a pillar within our chapters.
