How to record your IP cameras and video surveillance systems?

First, you have to determine which type of cameras you have or you are going to buy. Although choosing a surveillance camera might seem daunting, if you follow a few easy steps, you can select one that fits your needs.

- 1. Decide if you need a day camera or a day-and-night camera. For instance, a day-and-night camera can see in infrared and provides ongoing security on the darkest of nights.
- 2. Look for a camera that offers panning, tilting, and zooming (PTZ). Using PTZ cameras a homeowner or a security guard can shifts the camera's focus.
- 3. Examine the camera's protective cover. For instance, some cameras come with a metal visor to protect the lens. Others come with a globe that fits around the entire camera.
- 4. Decide whether you need a camera for indoor or for outdoor use.
- 5. Consider the price, and make sure it fits your budget. Surveillance cameras cost from as little as \$50 to as much as \$1,000.
- 6. Determine what type of recording media you need. For instance, some camera systems employ DVR technology. Others save information on a computer hard drive. DVR or hard-drive recording systems can cost \$500.
- 7. Select a camera with adequate frames per second (fps) rate and adequate resolution.
- 8. Determine if you need real-time monitoring. For businesses, real-time monitoring can alert police immediately upon detecting an intrustion.
- 9. Review the installation specifications. If you can install the camera yourself, you'll save money. Some camera systems carry hefty installation fees of more than \$250.



Both cameras have some important common features and functions:

- Embeded Web Server enables remote control of the camera and surveillance via a web browser.
- Support for wireless and wired networks.
- With automatic opened infrared rays, night vision distance can reach up to 10 metres.
- Giving alarm in cause of motion detection and sending an image to your mailbox automatically when the IP CAM is triggered.
- Two-way talk audio function.
- Pan/Tilt function (changing the direction).
- Video resolution of 640x480 pixels at frame rate of 15 fps.
