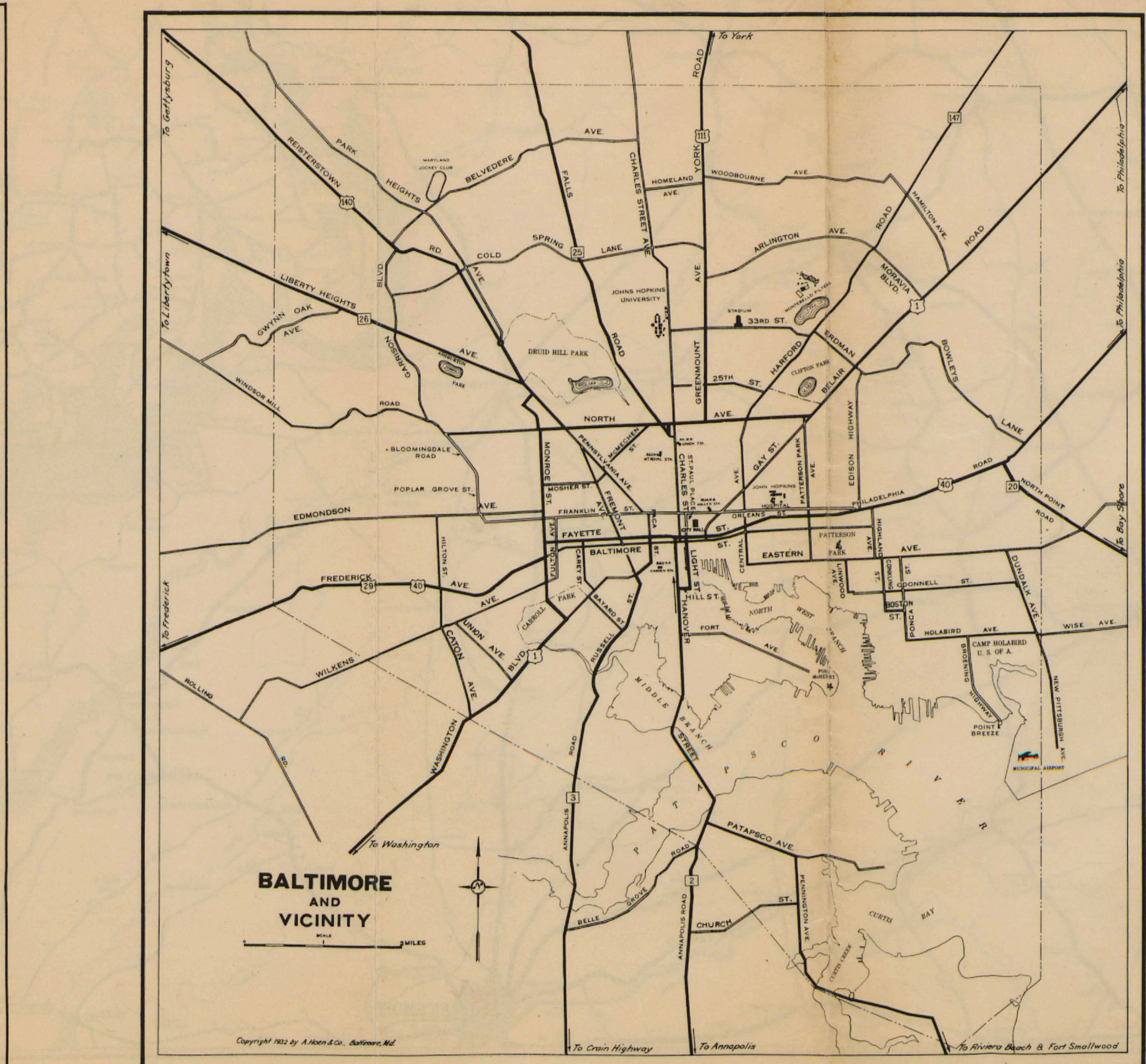
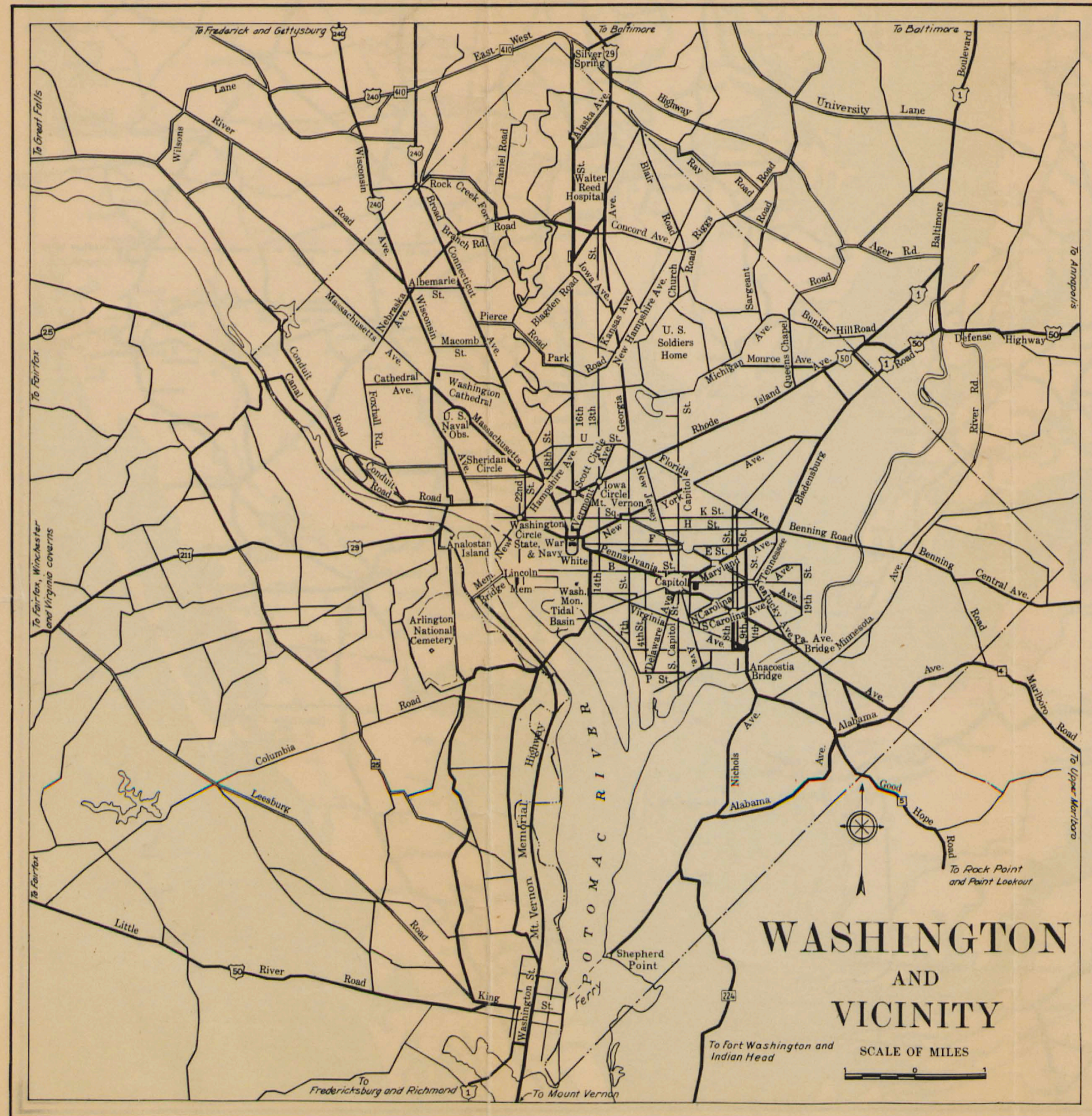


MAP OF

points in adjoining States



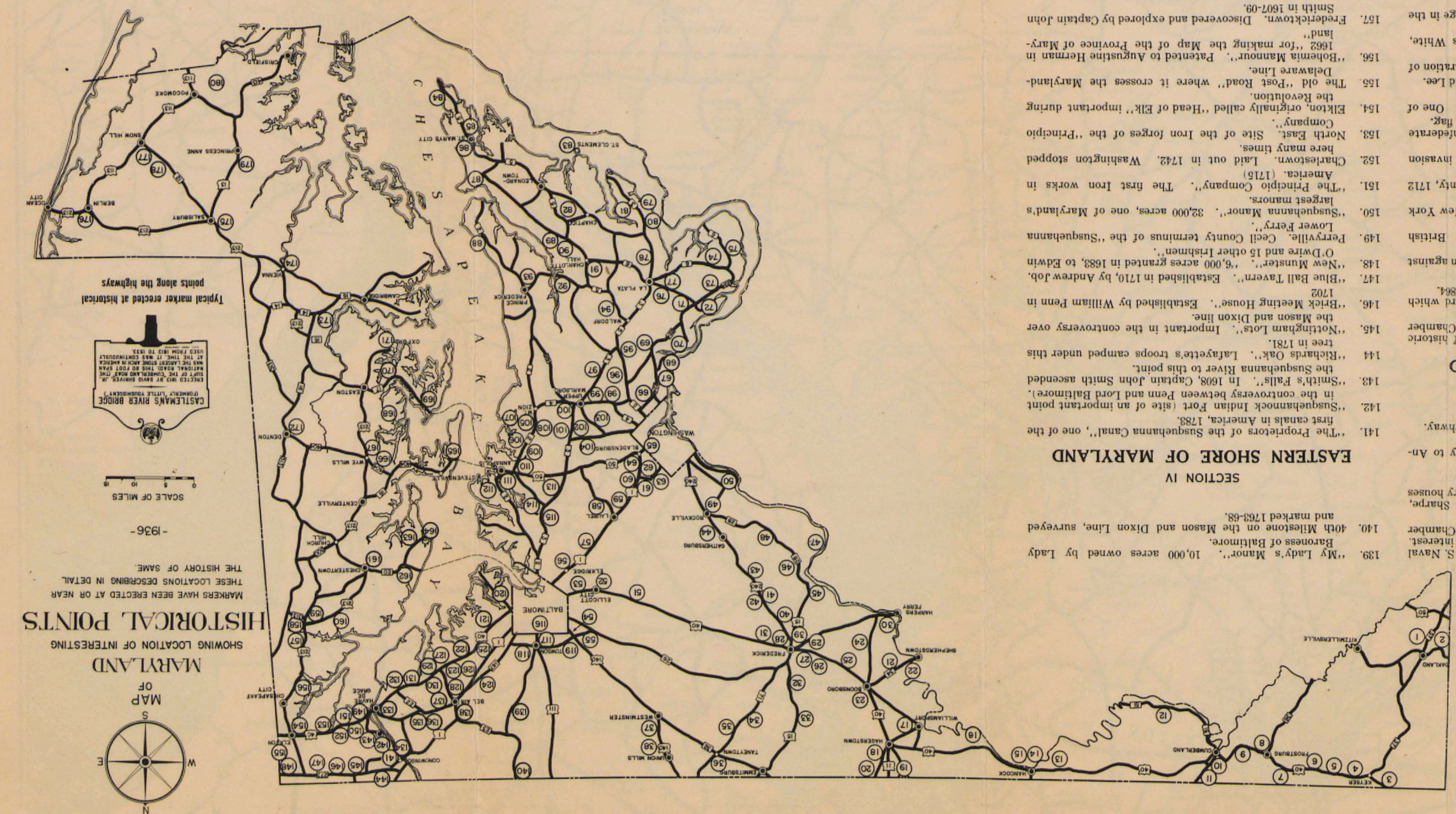
