Dr. Sadashiv Shrotriya is an Indian litterateur writing in Hindi and English since sixties. A retired professor of English literature from Rajasthan University, Shrotriya kept writing for connoisseurs. He wrote his thesis on Anglo-Walsh poet R.S. Thomas. His weekly column in Hindustan Times was much admired and talked about that dealt with social changes and perversions with urbanization. His first poem was published in 1965 in a Hindi magazine 'Lahar'. In 1976, his story 'Pratham Varsh' won the first prize in the prestigious Hindi monthly 'Kahaani'.

His first book of poetry-'Prathama' was published in 1989 and the second book titled – 'Moolya Sankraman ke Daur Mein' appeared in 2011. It is the compilation of his articles published in various magazines.

He writes regularly for Hindi Newspapers- 'Jansatta' and 'Rajasthan Patrika'.

He is also associated with an organization called 'SPIC MACAY' that promotes Indian classical music and culture amongst youth.
