SHIELD FOR RURAL TOURISTS.

Northwestern Road Posts Mechanical City Guide in Its Depot at Chicago.

Another blow at the confidence men who haunt the stations and furnish to travelers gratuitous information concerning tunnel explosions and similar attractions was struck the other day at Chicago, when an electrical directory and time table device was placed in the Chicago & Northwestern depot at Wells and Kinzie streets.

By means of the directories the tourist who desires to visit any place of interest in Chicago need but press a button on a cabinet, which bears a striking resemblance to a large upright piano, and with a whirling of wheels a sheet will be brought to view and will furnish information as to street car lines to be traveled over to reach any part of the city.

The time tables are placed upon 26 sheets. The towns and cities on the road and on connecting lines are arranged alphabetically, each sheet being devoted to a letter.
