- First African-American driver in history to successfully complete a full season the Indy Racing League – 16<sup>th</sup> overall in points.
- Winner of the Indianapolis 500 Qualifying Driver Consistency Award – Qualified at 227.150 MPH.
- Second African-American driver in history to qualify and complete the Indianapolis 500; 2002 IRL Rookie of the Year runner-up finishing higher in points than *Dan Weldon, Buddy Rice, Vitor Meira, Tony Renna and Anthony Lazzaro*.
- Finished the entire Indy Racing League season in the “Top 20” except for only 2 races; with four “Top 15” finishes.
- Featured subject in over 1,320,000 internet articles worldwide, 18 magazine publications, 3 national TV specials and 15 syndicated radio programs – without the services of a public relations firm.
- Positive lifestyle and personality have placed him in worldwide PR campaigns with trendsetting celebrities such as Shawn “Jay-Z” Carter, Damon Dash, Kevin Bacon and supermodels Naomi Campbell and Karolina Kurkova.
- Winner of three (3) National Karting Championships and the first African-American to win an International Karting Championship; represented the United States in the World Championships (1995).
- Voted won the “Top 50” Karting race car drivers in Kart racing history and was the first African-American on the cover of Kart Racer Magazine.
