FINAL JUDGMENT

This action came on for hearing before the Court on Defendant Landmark Education Corporation's Motion for Summary Judgment and Brief in Support filed March 14, 2007. Because the Plaintiff filed no timely response to that motion, all material facts set forth in the motion's factual statement that are supported by acceptable evidentiary material are deemed admitted for the purpose of summary judgment. Having considered the merits of the motion, the Court finds that there is no substantial controversy as to the material facts and that Landmark Education Corporation (now Landmark Education LLC) ("Landmark") is entitled to judgment as a matter of law.

The Court further finds that although another defendant is named herein who is not affected by the disposition of Landmark's motion, the Court directs the preparation and filing of a judgment in favor of Landmark, finds that there is no just reason for delay in the filing of such judgment, and directs the immediate filing of such judgment, all pursuant to 12 O.S. § 994(A).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that judgment be entered in favor of Defendant Landmark on the claims asserted against it by the Plaintiff, Jeanne Been, as executrix of the estate of Robert Jenkins, deceased, and that this judgment shall be final pursuant to 12 O.S. § 994(A).
