Foreign News.—The Liverpool packet ship York, Captain Nash De Cost, arrived yesterday afternoon, bringing regular files of London and Liverpool papers, the former to the 23d, and the latter to the 24th of June inclusive.

The Manchester packet ship, whose day of sailing from Liverpool was the 1st July, is telegraphed us below; but the intelligence from her cannot reach town till this evening.

From Colombia.—We learn from Capt. Whitaker, of the brig Hiram, from Laguna and Porto Cabello, that when he sailed from the latter port every necessary preparation was making to despatch the Colombian fleet to the Pacific.

Intelligence was received in London on the 22d, by the steam boat from Hamburg, confirming the report which we formerly gave, that the bombardment of Silistria by the Russians had commenced.

In Portugal, execution are still continued under the orders of Dou Miguel. A number of Portuguese gentlemen had effected their escape from Oporto in an English vessel, and had arrived at Dublin.

The Parliament was to be prorogued on the 24th of June. In Clere the election was proceeding—the supposition is that Mr. O'Connell will be returned.

The King of Spain, who recently lost his wife, yielding to the wishes of the nation, is about to send an ambassador to Naples to solicit the hand of Royal Highness, the Princess Donna Maria Christine.

Letters from Lisbon, of the 6th June, mention that the Government of his Most Faithful Majesty had despatched a courier to the last despatches from London.

The news of the precipitate retreat of the Captain Pacha into the Boaphorus is fully confirmed. It seems certain, however, that while this fleet was in the Black Sea the vessels laden with corn
