SUBJECT: 20 January 2010 Detainee Review Board (DRB) Legal Review, ISN 0459

1. I reviewed the findings and recommendations of the DRB that convened on 20 January 2010 concerning the internment of Detainee ISN 0459 and find them legally sufficient.
2. The DRB found that ISN 0459 meets the criteria for continued internment for the reasons outlined in the DRB President's Memorandum found at Enclosure 1.
3. After taking into account the detainee's potential for rehabilitation, reconciliation, and eventual reintegration into society, the Board recommends continued internment at the Detention Facility in Parwan. The DRB determined that internment is necessary to mitigate the threat ISN 0459 poses.
4. The DRB did not assess ISN 0459 to be an Enduring Security Threat.
