- Serbian version: 31,100 articles
- Spanish version: 5300 articles






- Suggest best practices for Wikinews

- 10,000 reads per hour




- Wikinews members are "ex-pats" from Wikipedia
- Citizen journalism lesson: treat to involve citizens to Wikinews
- Even though, most of the Wikipedians are not interested in collaborate



## **Neutral Point of View**

- Essential pillar
- Make difference from other private media:
  - No commitments with governments, businesses, nationalist, ideological or racial interests.
  - No funding problems



## Same information, different audiences


- Latin American style
- Notes must have interest for a wide region
- Reader and creator interested on Latin America news



#### A news becomes history

- Library of Congress of the United States announced it will file daily tweets of Twitter
- Free future repository of historical news.





# Wikinews, part of a democratic society

- Contribute to democracy and a better society
- Free future repository of historical news.
- Some Latin American countries share problems in the practice of journalism: censorship, governmental coercive, personal safety.





- Performance of citizen journalism workshops in deriving results for Wikinews.
- Linking school with Authorities and Nongovernmental Organizations interested in citizen journalism.







- Definition of non official sources (politics, sports, culture, society). A clearer division of labor in terms and affinities is most prolific.
- Promotion of editors with oversight and recommendation of new content.
