Some facts...

- 72 (and growing) participants.
 - All volunteers
 - From almost all the Spanish regions (including those with vernacular language)
 - Many from educational or university backgrounds
 - Wide range of ages (17 60+)
 - Many participants with 2 or more spoken languages
 - An open and collaborative style
 - Open lists
 - Blog/Twitter/Facebook
 - All Spanish based projects involved (an, ast, ca, es, eu, ext, gl...)
- Possibility of local groups (non centralist structure)



Chronology

- **Multiple meetings** (Valladolid, Madrid, Palencia, Barcelona, Valencia, Sevilla, Cádiz, Santiago de Compostela, Bilbao...)
- April-May 2010: Bylaws and Board.
- October 2010: Approved by ChapCom
- February 2011: Approved by WMF Board
 - Registered under spanish law
 - Bank account (Barclays)
- March 2011: Signing of the Chapter's Agreement

- Immediate agreement between WM-ES and Fundación ONCE to help blind and otherwise challenged people access WM projects.
 - Agreement between 2 non-profit organizations
 - With an interdisciplinary team
 - To benefit **all** Wikimedia projects, in **all** languages
- ONCE implement integration programmes of work-related training and employment for people with disabilities, and universal accessibility, promoting the creation of universally accessible environments, products and services.
