WEDNESDAY (MORNING) MAY 19, 1830.

Extract of a letter to the Times dated 15th May, 1830.

Presuming that it will be acceptable, I proceed to communicate some of the latest intelligence at this place.

We have had a number of wrecks lately; among the latest are the British brig Sappho, from New-Orleans bound to Liverpool...

By the arrival of the brig Louisiana, Capt. Patton at Baltimore from New York...
