Architectural design elements include wall and floor finishes, elevators, escalators, lighting and signage in all the new stations. The intent of this design approach is to create a unified look which is both practical, and allows each station to retain its individual identity.

Designers of each station and the Crossrail network are working extensively with neighborhood residents and businesses to ensure that the benefits of each station extend past the ticketing gates to the surronding neighborhoods and beyond.

The Custom House Station will be the only new station for Crossrail passengers. This station has been identified as the 'Gateway to London' and will be the only new Crossrail station where platforms are above ground.

Canary Wharf will be a densely urban subterranian station with four or the six storeys being dedicated to retail. In addition to shopping Canary Wharf will have a landscaped park, restaurant, and community facility on the top floor. The station will be covered by a semi open-air timber lattice roof creating a transparent and inviting pedestrian environment.
