WIKIPEDIA TAKES MONTREAL BY PHOTO

Montreal, August 8, 2011 - For the 10th anniversary of the encyclopedia Wikipedia, the Wikimedia Canada foundation is hosting a large photo scavenger hunt in Montreal on Sunday, August 28, 2011.

Wikipedia contributors have identified over 300 targets in Montreal, and they invite people to photograph these attractions in order to add new images to encyclopedia articles about Quebec's largest city. Registration is free, there is more than \$1,000 to be won, and amateur photographers will also have the chance to see their best photos appear on the Wikipedia's home page.

"Wikipedia takes Montreal" is part of the "Wikipedia Takes Your City" series of events, named after the song "First We Take Manhattan" by Leonard Cohen. Past photo scavenger hunts have taken place in Manhattan, Chicago, Nashville, Berlin, Amsterdam, Manila, Grenoble, Cognac, Saint-Malo, and over thirty other cities worldwide.
