THE SUB SUBS

As per Krishnamurthi Padathi there are:

1. 12 signs in the zodiac
2. 27 nakshatras or asterisms or stars
3. 9 graha or planets who are lords of 3 nakshatras each
4. Each nakshatra covers a span of 13° 20' of the arc
5. Each nakshatra is divided into 9 unequal divisions and each division is known as sub-lord (the details of which have been given in part I and part II)
6. These 9 sub lords are further divided SUB-SUBS.
