VIII. *An Account of the Diſſection of a Dog that had Mercury injected into one of the Jugulars. By Dr. Chriſtoph. Pitt.*

THE Mercury was thrown out of the Blood into the Cavity of the Abdomen, as likewise ſome Appearance of it in the other Cavities of the Body.

All the Glandules were very turgid, and full of Liquor, eſpecially in the Ventricles of the Brain, and all round there was a great Quantity of Serum. This may be called a true *Hydrocephalus*.
