
Party Divisions of U.S. Congress



Blue indicates control by Democratic Party, Red indicates control by Republican Party. Lines indicate number of Democratic seats held in either the Senate or House. * The 107th Congress (2001–2003) was evenly split between Democrats and Republicans; however, because the tie-breaking vote in the Senate was Republican (Vice-President Dick Cheney), this Congress was coded as Republican.
