It is in seasons such as this that we learn to know and appreciate the large amount of real good that thes dormant is mankind. The great post of human nature told us long since that the uses of adversity were sweet; and the experience of ages confirms the axiom. Adversity calls forth the tenderest tympathies which dwell in our bearts, kindles the sacred fire of love, teaches us the laxury of doing good, and thus resignate by that senument of inward astisfaction is which no other earthly delight is comparable. Equally beautiful and philosophically true is the remark we have seen quited, that but for the sorrows of the heart, where would the affections find their strength? Our virtues, like certain aromatic heries of the forest, only give out their sweets when their leaves are bruised and trampied.
