The entire proceedings of the anti-slavery association of New Orleans, the peculiarity of which are noticed more in terms of commendation, will be found "elsewhere." That this laudable and worthy undertaking operates at least in decreasing an evil which all do, cannot fail to be the fervent prayer of every philanthropist and friend to humanity.

We have Liverpool dates to the 27th, and London, to 29th July.

The city council at their last sitting, devoted a considerable portion of their time in discussing (financially) the duties of the surveyor, upon a resolution requiring him to make a map of the city and its suburbs. One member (Mr. Marry) contended strenuously, that he was not bound to do this without additional compensation; that the plan of the city was his property, and that it amounted to a sort of monopoly. The committee to whom the resolution was referred, voted that all the evidence in their power should be adduced to lay before the Corporation, and that the project should be abandoned.

Resolved, that every responsible citizen has the right to add his name to the original map, in confirmation to the rules and regulations of this meeting.

Unanimously, the members were agreed to Mr. John Davis, for the use of his rooms.

The meeting then adjourned to meet at the next con-
