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CHARTER

STATE OF LOUISIANA PARISH OF ORLEANS. JEROME CITY OF NEW ORLEANS.

BE IT KNOWN that on this 15th day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and six, before me, J. J. Young, Notary Public, residing in the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana.

BEFORE ME, JOHN E. KURTIS, a Notary Public, duly sworn, commissioned and qualified, and in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, who has read the above and foregoing Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. The name of this corporation shall be the CALIFORNIA LUMBER COMPANY, and under the said corporate name it shall have power and authority to acquire and operate a sawmill and other industrial enterprises.

ARTICLE II. The domicile of this corporation shall be in the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, and the principal office of the corporation shall be in the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana.

ARTICLE III. The capital stock of this corporation shall be \$500,000 divided into and represented by 50,000 shares of stock of the par value of ten dollars each.

ARTICLE IV. All the corporate powers of said corporation shall be vested in and exercised by a Board of Directors to be composed of three to five directors.

ARTICLE V. The Board of Directors shall have power and authority to exercise any of the powers conferred upon it by the charter, and to make and alter its by-laws.

ARTICLE VI. Whenever this corporation may be dissolved, either by liquidation or from any other cause, the assets of the corporation shall be sold and the proceeds thereof distributed to the stockholders.

ARTICLE VII. The Board of Directors shall have power and authority to exercise any of the powers conferred upon it by the charter, and to make and alter its by-laws.

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
