

INFLUENCE OF SIGNS, NAKSHATRAS AND PLANETS ON MEDICAL STUDIES AND PROFESSION IN BRIEF.

- 1. The sign Virgo is called as the Health Centre (Hospitl) of the zodiac.
- 2. According to Hindu tradition, Bhaskara (Sun God) gave the knowledge of medicine to Dhanvantari (one of his 16 disciples) and Dhanvantari first revealed Ayurveda to the world. Hence Sun is a significator of medicine.
- 4. Moon is known s Aushadapathi, the lord of the study of medicine as it was the custom since ancient times to see on which makshatra Moon was before plucking the herbs for preparing medicines.
- 5. Nakshatras or asterisms like Mrigasira, Chitra, zUttarashada and Punarvasu are connected with medicine, medical men and surgeons.
- 6. Nakshatras Asvini, Magaha and Moola also control and influence medicine and and influence medical studies and professions.

I was introduced to the native in June 1993. His father wanted to know in which stream he should proceed to carry out his higher education after SSCE. At that moment, after looking at his rasi chart (koka kundali) I just said that science was a better stream suited to his son. His father replied that he has already taken admission in the Science stream and gave me his data (as above) and asked me to make a detailed study.

After studying his chart through the Nirayana and Sayana methods, I dedcided to view it through the Krishnamurthi Padathi. This system is based on the signs of the zodiac and the 27 nakshatras, which are divided into star lords and sub lords and directions are through the vimshottari dasha system. An attempt has been made to keep this case study (as it is the first one) very simple, limiting it only to the sign, star and sub lords.

The main question is why did he take up the study of medical science and specialize in surgery, that too specializing as an orthopedic surgeon.

- 1. According to K.P. system, the sign Virgo, the sixth sign counted from Aries, is connected with health, health care, healing, etc. In very vague terms it is also known as the Hospital of the Zodiac. Many planets in that sign influences a native to go in for study and occupations of health, sanitation, etc. In this particular case, we the Sun, Mars and Mercury in Virgo along with the extra-Saturnian planets, Uranus and Pluto. In K.P. system aspect are taken for the whole sign rather than degreecally as done in the Sayana sytem. Hence these planets are associated with each other.
- 2. According to Hindu tradition the Sun (on Hastha Nakshatra in Virgo) is considered as a significator of medicine as he is associated with Dhanvantari, who revealed Ayurveda to the world, and this belief is made amply clear in the following words:

"According to the tradition given in *Brahmavaivartapurana*, the creator of the universe, while studying the four Vedas, separated Ayurveda from them. He is then stated to have imparted the knowledge of this science to Bhaskara (sun-god). Surya, thereafter, wrote his own samhita on Ayurveda and taught the same to 16 disciples of whom Dhanvantari was the foremost. According to the *Srimad Bhagavata Purana*, it was Bhagavan Dhanvantari, who revealed Ayurveda to the world. This Dhanvantari, who is said to be the original or the first, has been known as Adi-Dhanvantari. He is worshipped even today as the presiding deity of medical science. Being a very skilled surgeon according to the standards of his time, he is widely believed to be the pioneer of modern medical practices like plastic surgery. Albeit his methods were a lot cruder and more painful and were used only in emergencies, such as on the injuries of war victims."

- The Sun is conjunct Mars and Pluto (both are on Uttara Phalguni, the star of Sun) in the ninth bhava. The ninth bhava is considered to higher education and research. Hence during the dasha of the Sun, commencing June 1993, he took up his further studies in the science stream.
- 3. Moon, along with Venus, is on Magha Nakshatra, in the sign Leo. Ashwini, Magha and Moola also control medicine and healing. Further, Moon is also called Ausadhapati, the lord of medicine. In India right from ancient time, herbs used to be collected when the Moon was on a particular asterism or nakshatra, after chanting the prescribed mantas. It is also said that medicines administered to a patient when the Moon is on Asvini nakshatra at times gives astounding results and healing effects. During the dasha of Moon, commencing from June 1999, he did his M.D. in surgery. Moon is tenanting the eight bhava on the Star of Magha. Eight house also signifies the operation theatre, Moon is aspected by Jupiter and Jupiter is on the star of Mula which also signifies medicine.
- 4. Mercury, the planet of skilful diagnosis is on Chitra nakshatra, and degreecally on Spica. This nakshatra produces skilful doctors and surgeons. Further Mercury is the lord of the tenth house and also in the tenth bhava, The influence of Mercury is felt tremendously on the native which is in association with Urnaus, the Sun, Mar and Pluto sign-wise.

5. Mars is on the star of Sun and according to K.P. the aspects are for the full sign. According to Hindu astrology, the conjunction or association of Mars and Sun, especially in Virgo, makes a surgeon. Mars is also associated with Pluto, Mercury and Uranus in the sign Virgo. Mars is also the lord of the twelfth bhava, which signifies the hospital. The twelfth bhava is aspected by Saturn who is on Mrigasira, the star ruled by Mars. Mrigasira also influence surgery, especially orthopedic surgery. The present dasha is that of Mars, which commenced from June 2009. I have been given to understand that he doing well as an orthopaedic surgeon in well-known hospitals of Mumbai, India.

The Mahadashas to follow are of:

- Rahu, on the star of Uttarashada ruled by Sun, aspected by Jupiter (conjunction), who is on the Star of Mula, whose lord is Ketu (in the Ascendant) and by Mars from the tenth (4th aspect). This mahadasha lasts for 18 years.
- Jupiter, Lord of Ascendant, on the star Mula, whose lord is Ketu. This mahadasha lasts for 16 years.

Conclusion: This case study is made simple as it is the first one. The intricacies of sub lords have not been mentioned. For those who are awaiting case studies with sub lords and sub subs will have to wait for some time as there are many readers who have not come up to that level. At the same time, we wish our Surgeon Friend nest of luck and blessings of the Almighty so that his mission to serve humanity be fulfilled and he should be an instrument to heal and bring happiness thereby to the unfortunate and afflicted.
