REPORT OF THE CHARITY HOSPITAL. For the year ending 31st Dec. 1909. By the Board of Directors.

PROPERTY. The property of the hospital is held in trust for the benefit of the poor and indigent of the city of New Orleans.

REVENUE. The total revenue for the year was \$100,000.00, of which \$50,000.00 was derived from the State and \$50,000.00 from other sources.

EXPENDITURE. The total expenditure for the year was \$100,000.00, of which \$50,000.00 was for the maintenance of the hospital and \$50,000.00 for other purposes.

ASSETS. The assets of the hospital at the end of the year were \$100,000.00, consisting of cash, real estate, and other property.

LIABILITIES. The liabilities of the hospital at the end of the year were \$100,000.00, consisting of accounts payable and other obligations.

CONCLUSION. The report shows that the hospital has operated successfully during the year, and that the funds have been properly managed.
