Pag. 22. Line 2. read, mixt and Obryze fort also, which has on it a horse, rudely design'd; with the Letters C O N O B. * *Constantinopolis Obrixatum*; * In Auro Nu. misname Valen- tiniani Cesaris. Others, some prince of ours. p. 51. l. 9. read *Etiminus*. I know very well Spanheme slighted this *Medal*; but I am not willing to degrade our Noble City of her so early *Metropolitan* Dignity, without a Demonstration, having a learned Person on my side. p. 207. in *Margine*, read for *Richborough*, *Re-Landum Comit-gulbium*.
