

JTF-GTMO Assessment Afghanistan/Pakistan Detainee's

29 March 2004

ISN: US9AF-000952DP

Health Assessment: ISN 952 has latent tuberculosis, but is currently in good health. He has no known drug allergies.

Background and Capture Data: The detainee was a leader in his community. Detainee claims he is not a member of Al-Qaida or Taliban. Detainee blames his capture on USAF-000950DP and proclaims innocence for himself and USAF000951DP. Detainee also believes that one of his dinner guests named Haji Saed Sha Agha, was once a Taliban member and possible a bodyguard for Mullah Omar. US forces captured detainee at his home. Detainee was captured with USAF-000950DP and USAF-000951DP. Capturing source provided information of a meeting at that residence involving future plans to conduct attacks against U.S. and coalition forces.

Date of Capture: 29 January 2003

Risk Level: Medium

Risk Assessment: Detainee has not provided enough information on his capture situation to warrant any release in the near future. The detainee and others captured with him (US9AF-000950DP, US9AF-000951DP) continue to produce conflicting information about occurrences before their arrest. Detainee has suspected associations with the Taliban, subversive operatives and

Intelligence Value: Medium

Exploitation Requirements: Information on US9AF-000950DP and US9AF-000951DP. Possible information pertaining to the alleged attack against US and coalition forces and terrorist groups and personalities related to the attack.
