present during much of the meeting was [Redacted]. Abu Zubaidah was advised that [Redacted]

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[Redacted] Abu Zubaidah advised he did understand. Abu Zubaidah answered yes when asked if he wanted the information processed and released. Abu Zubaidah advised signing the privacy statement for Leopold was voluntary.

Abu Zubaidah stated he signed the privacy statement for Leopold in hopes an article written by Leopold would help him

gain status in the US and obtain a green card. Abu Zubaidah advised the article is not something he wants written, but he feels he has no other option. Abu Zubaidah currently has no status in the US and is fearful he could be deported at any moment. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Abu Zubaidah feels he has proven he is not a terrorist and considers himself an American. Abu Zubaidah fears he [REDACTED] if he does not gain status in the US. He hopes the article will be read by someone who can help him with this matter.

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Leopold contacted Abu Zubaidah [REDACTED] after [REDACTED] Several years ago [REDACTED] various government officials and news organizations. [REDACTED] stated Leopold appears very eager to write a story about Abu Zubaidah and has contacted many individuals and organizations regarding Abu Zubaidah's past.
