A latent-impression, which is either from the lower joint area of a finger or a palm print, was compared with available fingerprints of but no identification effected. Impressions of lower joint areas of the fingers and palm prints of the hot contained identification Division files.

On basis of information furnished, no identification records were located for remaining seven individuals named in regirtel.
