SUBJECT: 1 October 2009 Detainee Review Board (DRB) Recommendation Approval/Disapproval for transfer of ISN 3932 to the Afghan National Detention Facility.

- 1. The Detainee Review Board conducted on 1 October 2009 reviewed the internment of Bahram (JAN)/ ISN 3932 and made the following findings and recommendation:
- a. That ISN 3932 is a person who was part of, or substantially supported, Taliban or al-Qaida forces or associated forces that are engaged in hostilities against the United States or its coalition partners, including any person who has committed a belligerent act, or has directly supported hostilities, in aid of such enemy armed forces.
 - b. That interment is necessary to mitigate the threat ISN 3932 poses.
 - c. That ISN 3932 is not an Enduring Security Threat.

2. I approve disapprove the transfer of ISN 3932 to the Afghan authorities for criminal prosecution.

[Detainee 3932 entered the boardroom and took his seat in front of the board members.]

The detainee was advised by the president of how this board was not a criminal trial and how this board was to determine whether or not he met the criteria for further internment.

The president also notified the detainee that he may be present at all open sessions of the board permitting that he acted appropriately. ISN 3932 was also advised that he could testify under oath or unsworn if he wished to do so, that he had a personal representative which was present at the hearing, that he may present information at the hearing including the testimony of witnesses, and that he can examine documents presented to the board all of which the detainee understood.

Further, ISN 3932 was instructed that, at the conclusion of the board after the legal review, the board would determine whether he met the criteria for further internment at the Bagram Theater Internment Facility. The detainee understood the fact that if he does not meet the criteria, then he would be released as soon as possible. However, if he did meet the criteria, then he would be recommended for further internment, transferred to Afghan authorities, or released without conditions.

[The unclassified hearing was called to order at 1022, 1 October 2009.]

Captain $^{(b)(3),\,10\,\,USC\,\,130b;\,(b)(6)}$ presented the following unclassified information to the board:

[Captain $^{\text{(b)(3), 10 USC 130b; (b)(6)}}$ presented the members of the board with Recorder Exhibits R-3932-1 and R-3932-2.]

[Per the recorders request, the president granted a classified hearing at the culmination of the unclassified hearing.]

The detainee, ISN 3932, made the following statement to the board:

I have a mental problem and I forget things. The IED materials are not mine. The explosive materials were given to me to take care of. The explosives were in a box and I did not know what was inside the box. The reporting on me was false.

The president allowed the board to ask the following questions of Detainee 3932:

QUESIONING OF ISN 3932

Questions by JA Recorder 2:

I have always been cooperative.

Questions by President:

I buy and sell flowers. If I am released I would sell goods. I was threatened by the Taliban to cooperate.

Questions by Member 1:

The detainee made the following final statement:

I'm a poor person, you should capture the Taliban. U.S. is always very nice and I will help and cooperate if I am paid.

The president announced the conclusion of the unclassified hearing.

The president of the board instructed the detainee that he would be notified of the board's decision within a couple of weeks and that he would be released if the decision is made that further internment would not be required. However, if the board decided that further internment is required, he would be retained at the Bagram Theater Internment Facility, released to Afghan authorities for participation in a reconciliation program, or released without conditions. Furthermore, if continued internment was recommended, then an additional Detainee Review Board would be reconvened in 6 months.

[The unclassified hearing adjourned at 1044, 1 October 2009.]

[Detainee 3932 withdrew from the boardroom.]

[The classified hearing was called to order at 1045, 1 October 2009.]

The president and members of the board voted on ISN 3932. The votes were then collected and handed to the legal representative.
