CHARTER OF THE CONSUMERS MANUFACTURING AND LUMBER COMPANY.

United States of America. State of Louisiana. Parish of Iberville. City of New Orleans. BE IT KNOWN that on this day of the month of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand, nine hundred and eight...

ARTICLE I. The name of this corporation shall be the CONSUMERS MANUFACTURING AND LUMBER COMPANY.

ARTICLE II. The complete and entire powers shall be in the hands of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE III. The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized and established, shall be to manufacture and operate a saw mill, planing mill, and factory for the manufacture of all kinds of lumber, shingles, lath, and other wood products.

ARTICLE IV. The capital stock of said corporation is hereby fixed at the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars.

ARTICLE V. All of the corporate powers of said corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI. The Board of Directors shall be composed of three stockholders to be elected annually on the first day of October of each year.

ARTICLE VII. The Board of Directors shall have the right to borrow money, to issue bonds, and to do all such other acts and things as may be necessary for the proper management of the business.

ARTICLE VIII. The Board of Directors shall have the right to change the name of the corporation, to alter its objects and purposes, and to dissolve the corporation.
