The "Secours Louisianais à la France.

Many fear in sending aid to Europe that the ship may fall a victim of the submarine and the assistance never reach its destination. It is, however, safer by the southern route direct from New Orleans, and the ladies of the "Secours" have been made very happy by the arrival of their December shipment in good condition.

The following letters will be of great interest to their numerous contributors. One from Havre from the headquarters of the Society of the Relief for the Wounded is addressed to Mrs. de Roaldès as follows:

Havre, February 7. Madame, I beg to acknowledge the handsome and generous gifts which you have sent our Red Cross Society, namely, cases Nos. 239, 240, 241 by the S. S. Carolina, cases Nos. 242, 243 by S. S. Georgie, which were delivered to us at the same time so that you will understand how we happen to be so late in writing to you.

We are extremely grateful to you, and to the "Secours Louisianais à la France" for the interest and sympathy shown to us. I need not add how useful your gifts will be to our poor boys at the front. We have forwarded cases 239, 240 and 241 to Verdun, where the warm underclothing will be greatly appreciated. The boxes 242, 243, 245 have been sent to our Central depot in Paris, where they will be expedited to the ambulances nearest the Somme. Our president and the members of the Society join with me in renewed thanks for the great kindness of this help to our soldiers. Referring to the clothing not new, but in good condition, sent by the "Secours", Mrs. de Roaldès has also received a letter of acknowledgment from the official society, which takes charge of clothing for refugees. It is as follows:

Paris, February 7. Madame, We are in possession of the last shipment of the "Secours Louisianais à la France", which your letter of December 27 announced. We beg to be the interpreter to the generous donors of our thanks for the interest they show in our work of distributing clothing among the refugees. The committee, as well as I, personally, are more than grateful for the help the "Secours" gives us. Those recently repatriated from the departments momentarily occupied, have come to us in unusually large numbers since the end of December. Their poverty and need is touching, their courage and endurance admirable. In their names too I thank your committee. The recent admirable action of President Wilson, which history will never forget, causes in France, and among the Allies, deep emotion, and we, more than other nations, bless the generous humanity shown to us by the American people during this terrible war. This friendship of which they have given so many proofs is now emphasized by official acts which cause us profound joy and we cry hurrah with all our hearts. The case arrived in perfect condition; its contents are very useful.

Should we become involved in the war, the fighting must be in France, and with the difficulties of transportation, whatever Red Cross supplies can be sent to France will be available for Americans, too, and most valuable as we have but one naval hospital ship, the "Solace". For this reason, a United States official high in authority said: "You cannot do better at present than to continue to work for the fighters in France."
