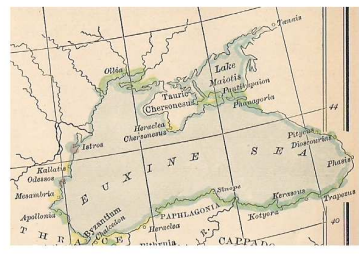
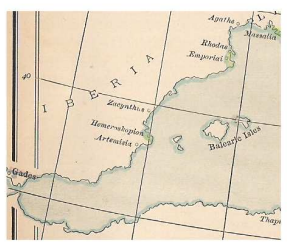
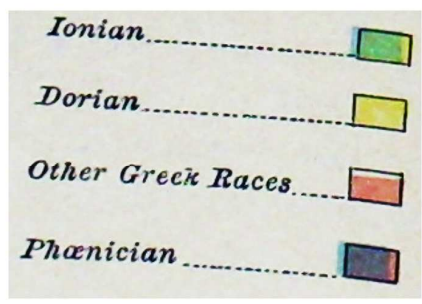
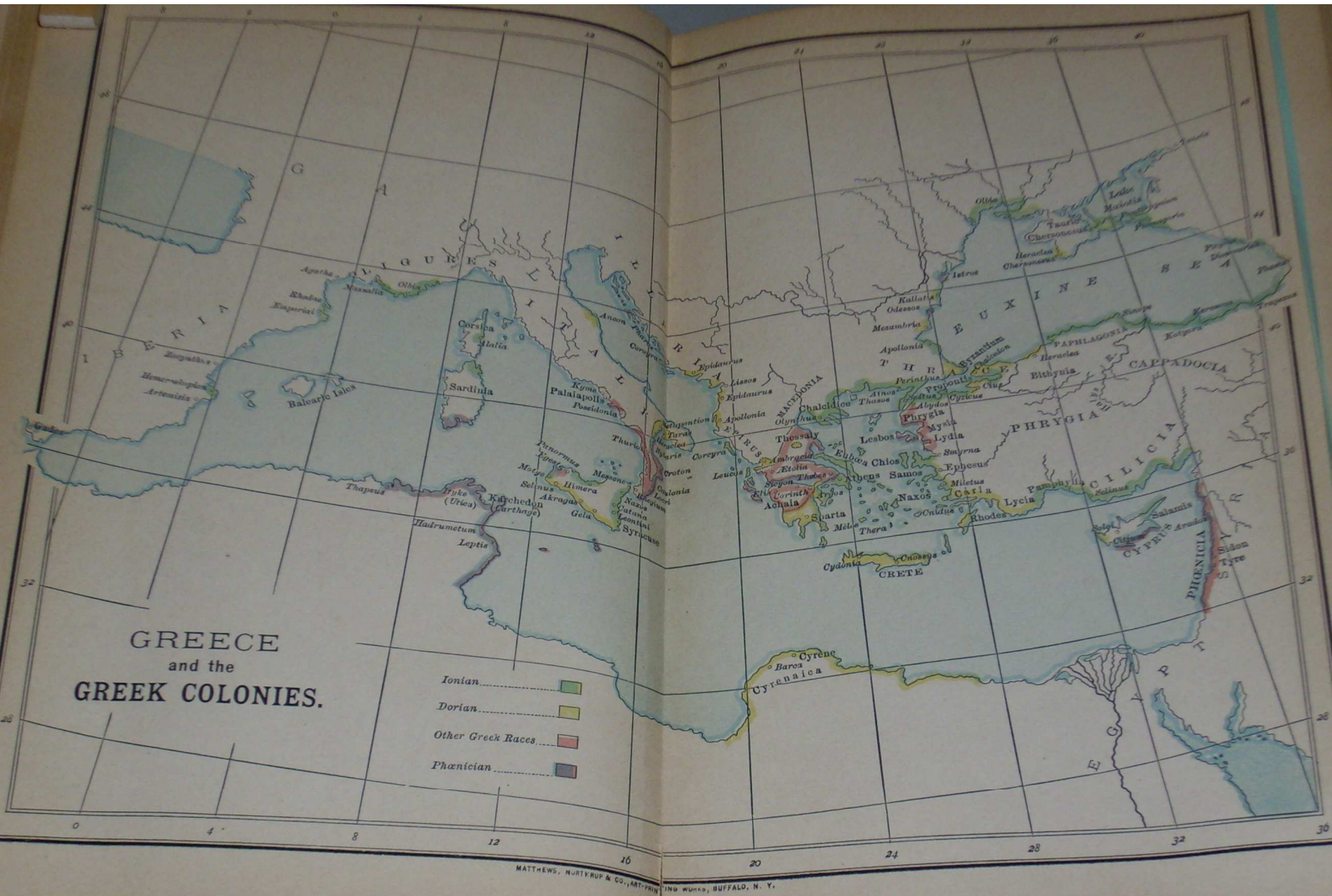


MAP OF THE
