CHARTER.

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. CITY OF NEW ORLEANS. Be it known, That on this twenty-first day of the Month of August, in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and seven, Before me, JAMES TOURGEOISE, Notary Public in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, duly authorized, qualified, and in and to the said City of New Orleans, personally came and appeared the persons whose names are hereunto subscribed, who severally declared that, availing themselves of the provisions of the laws of Louisiana, they had organized an organization of corporations, they have formed and organized, and do by these presents form themselves, their successors and assigns into and constitute a corporation of the name and nature of the object and purpose of the corporation, and under the name of the corporation, and in and to the said City of New Orleans, they have adopted their Charter, to-wit:

ARTICLE IV. The capital stock of this corporation is hereby fixed at One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) divided into One thousand shares of One hundred dollars each, which said shares shall be paid for in cash or by installments, at the discretion of the stockholders, at the time that the same is issued. All transfers of stock shall be made on the books of said Company by the signature of the stockholder or his authorized agent, and the same shall be subject to the same conditions as are provided for in the Charter of this Corporation. Said capital stock may be increased to the amount of Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) or may be decreased by proceedings in accordance with the requirements of the laws of this State. Should the said capital stock be increased the existing stockholders shall have the right to take shares of the additional stock in proportion to the number of shares then owned by them within thirty days after the increase shall have been made. This Company shall have the right to commence business with Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) of the capital stock shall have been paid for.

ARTICLE V. All the corporate powers and authority of this corporation shall be vested in a President, a Vice-President and General Manager, a Secretary and Treasurer, who shall constitute a Board of Directors, and shall be exercised as follows: The president shall have the power to conduct the business of said corporation, subject to the control of a two-thirds majority of all the members of the Board of Directors, who shall own in his own name, at least five shares of the capital stock of this corporation, and shall be elected at an annual meeting of the stockholders to be held on the second Monday in June of each year. All elections shall be by ballot and held at the office of said corporation under the superintendence of two commissionaires to be appointed for that purpose by the Board of Directors. Each share of stock shall be entitled to one vote to be cast by its owner, either in person or by proxy, and a majority of the votes cast shall elect. This corporation shall not be dissolved by failure to hold an annual meeting and to elect Directors thereat, but in such cases the Board of Directors shall call a meeting to be held as soon thereafter as possible. The first annual meeting of the stockholders shall be held on the Fourth Tuesday in August, A. D. 1907. Until the said first annual meeting the Board of Directors of this Company shall be composed of the following persons, to-wit: Adolfo Dugue, President, Marlin O. Woolfey, Vice-President and General Manager, Samuel D. Baker, Secretary and Treasurer. Both the directors above named and all thereafter elected shall continue in office until their successors shall have been elected and qualified.

ARTICLE VI. All elections shall be by ballot and held at the office of said corporation under the superintendence of two commissionaires to be appointed for that purpose by the Board of Directors. Each share of stock shall be entitled to one vote to be cast by its owner, either in person or by proxy, and a majority of the votes cast shall elect. This corporation shall not be dissolved by failure to hold an annual meeting and to elect Directors thereat, but in such cases the Board of Directors shall call a meeting to be held as soon thereafter as possible. The first annual meeting of the stockholders shall be held on the Fourth Tuesday in August, A. D. 1907. Until the said first annual meeting the Board of Directors of this Company shall be composed of the following persons, to-wit: Adolfo Dugue, President, Marlin O. Woolfey, Vice-President and General Manager, Samuel D. Baker, Secretary and Treasurer. Both the directors above named and all thereafter elected shall continue in office until their successors shall have been elected and qualified.

ARTICLE VII. Both the stockholders subscribing this charter, and all future stockholders, agree mutually with each other not to dispose of their stock without the written consent of the Board of Directors, and to hold their shares in the corporation as long as they shall be entitled to the same, and to allow another stockholder to have the privilege of purchasing said stock at the price fixed by the stock value, as shown in the preceding trial balance. In case of the purchase of stock by the existing stockholders, they shall acquire the same in the proportion to which they already hold stock in the corporation. If any one of the stockholders declines to purchase the stock, any other stockholder may purchase the same in the proportion to which they already hold stock in the corporation. No stockholder shall ever be held liable or responsible for the contracts or debts of this corporation in any further sum than the unpaid balance due to the corporation on the shares owned by him, nor shall any more informally in organization have effect of rendering any stockholder liable of exposing a stockholder to any liability beyond the amount of his stock.

ARTICLE IX. At the termination of this charter by limitation or otherwise, the business and affairs of this corporation shall be liquidated, and the assets and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed among the stockholders at a meeting convened after ten days prior notice in writing shall have been given by the Secretary and Treasurer to each stockholder or his fully authorized agent. If the assets of the corporation shall be insufficient to pay the debts and liabilities of the corporation, the assets shall be sold and the proceeds thereof shall be distributed among the stockholders in proportion to the amount of their shares. This Act of incorporation may be changed, modified or altered by a vote of the stockholders, and the same shall be subject to the same conditions as are provided for in the Charter of this Corporation. The undersigned, Recorder of Mortgages, in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, do hereby certify that the above and foregoing articles of incorporation of Dugue & Company, incorporated, together with the certificate of the Recorder of Mortgages for the Parish of Orleans, are on file in the office of said Recorder of Mortgages, in and for the Parish of Orleans, August 27th, 1907.
