Ananti occupation of Florida.—The act providing for this undertaking having become a law, we among a synopsis or its provisions.

Section 1. Any head of a family or single man 18 years of age, capable of bearing arms, who has quade, or within a year from the plassage of the act, shall make an actual settlement in Florida muth of the lindividing townships 3 and 10 S, and east of the baseline, shall be entitled to one quarter section of land on these conditions—1st, of taking a permit from the Land Office describing his location; 2d, five year-residence; 31, the crection of a house fit for the labilitation of man, and the clearing, enclosing and cultivating five acree of land, and an actual residence thereon for four years; and 4th, that upon proof of compliance with these bonditions, a patent shall issue to him for the lands.

Sec. II. Provides a mode of settling controversies where two persons or more may have made the same location.

Sec. III. No right of location under this act, within two miles of any military post, established and garrisoned at the period of settlement.

Sec. IV. Fortida and annote all transactions of every sort for the transfer; sale or gift of such lands, and all liens thereon, before the issuing of the patent. Sec. V. Assures to the widow, or heiraclaw of any settler dying before by years, to before his patent is obtained, the benefit of such actilement.

Sec. VI. In case the life action is settled before actual survey, the School Commissioners shall select other lands in lieu of the life.

Sec. VII. Not exceeding 200,000 agree to be taken up under this act,
