**A BILL**

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, relating to lawful possession of a firearm near a school and affirm the right of States to regulate such possession.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO TITLE 18.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922 of title 18, United  
5 States Code, is amended by—

6 (1) repealing subsection (q); and

7 (2) striking subsection (q) and inserting the fol-  
8 lowing:

9 “(q) Repealed.”.

1 (b) DEFINITION.—Section 921(a) of title 18, United  
2 States Code, is amended by—

3 (1) repealing paragraphs (25) and (26); and

4 (2) striking paragraphs (25) and (26) and in-  
5 sserting the following:

6 “(25) Repealed.

7 “(26) Repealed.”.

8 (c) STATES RIGHTS.—Is the sense of Congress that  
9 the State legislatures should determine whether or not en-  
10 acting laws establishing gun school free zones is—

11 (1) constitutional;

12 (2) consistent with State laws; and

13 (3) effective in preventing gun violence.
