
Come Celebrate the 100 th Birthday of Floyd Dominy

If you use water in the West for irrigation, personal, municipal, industrial, hydropower or recreation, you either directly or indirectly have been affected by Floyd Dominy. Floyd was the Commissioner of the Bureau of Reclamation from 1959 to 1969, and cumulatively with the Bureau of Reclamation from 1946-1969. During his tenure at Reclamation several large water projects that defined the Bureau of Reclamation and the West were either authorized or came on line:

- The Colorado River Storage Project
 - Glen Canyon Dam
 - Flaming Gorge Dam
 - Aspinall Unit dams
- The Central Arizona Project

- Construction of many features of the Central Valley Project
- Many other irrigation and water distribution features in each of the 17 Western states

Mr. Dominy's history with the Bureau of Reclamation and volatile relationship with the emerging conservation movement has been the subject of several books and films. Floyd Dominy is celebrating his 100th birthday this December.
