

LIST OF 100 MORE OF OTRANTO DEAD

Identified by Means of Duplicate Muster Rolls Sent from Washington to England.

TROOPSHIP LOST ON OCT. 6

Total Announced So Far, 307 Men,
Out of 372 Reported Drowned
or Missing.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 24.—The names of 100 soldiers of the American Army given up as missing as a result of the sinking of the troopship Otranto were announced by the War Department today. The Otranto was sunk on Oct. 6 in a collision with the P. & O. liner Kashmir off the British coast.

There were between 600 and 700 American troops on board, and press reports indicated at the time that probably 372 were lost. The muster rolls were lost when the ship went down and duplicates had to be sent to England. This explains the length of time required to establish the identity of the men lost or missing. A month ago the War Department issued a list containing the names of 200 of the lost. Later a list of seven lost was issued. Today's list of 100 brings the total so far announced as lost or missing to 307.
