

Babelfish



The Babel Fish is small, yellow, leech-like, and is a universal translator which simultaneously translates from one spoken language to another. Challenges for 2010



- Contacts with like-minded organisations (OpenStreetMap, Historical Dictionary of Switzerland, Foundation of Archives of Architects of Ticino, etc.)
- challenge: get donations portal with more information and credit card payment gateway, handle donation receipts automatically - number of donations increased to more than 1000
- other challenge: more community involvement and improvement of internal communication
