- ISO 639-3: 7602 languages
- Average vocabulary: 60,000 words 100,000 words
- OED: 300,000 words; 600,000 word forms
- Wikis can be that big.

The problem

- Different senses have different translations.
 - Board: a piece of wood
 - Swedish: bräda
 - Board: a committee
 - Swedish: styrelse
- Words and meaning do not have a one-to-one relationship.
- Languages divide concepts differently.





Hinge on Defined Meaning

- Translations create articles
- Translations
 remain
 associated with a
 meaning.
- Definition shows in the user's language

- A definition.
- Translate that definition.
- Add translations.
- Add synonyms.
- Translations link automatically.

- An attempt to close down or destroy existing Wiktionaries
- An English- or European-centric effort
- An effort only by volunteers: partners and specialized content
