The roots are made into medicine to treat measles in children, this can either be taken orally or used as a wash. The leaves are crushed and applied to wasp stings, this has a cooling effect and takes away the pain. The roots are pounded and left to soak in water, this mixture is medicine for coughs and malaria. The ripe fruit are mixed with other herbs and given as a drench for staring coat in cattle.
