


Customers buying new iSeries models in 2003

- WebSphere is included in many iSeries offerings
 - WAS-Express V5
 - WAS Advanced V4 (single server)
 - WAS V5 (base server)
- Software Maintenance
 - Eligible for one year Software Maintenance (no cost)
 - Must enroll/register in PPA
- Additional orders after initial purchase
 - Configurator (PID) vs. Passport Advantage (PPA)
 - WAS-Express PPA only
 - WAS V4 & WAS V5 PPA and PID
 - Configurator ordering (PID) going away in mid-2003
